Folk Art Revealed



William Edmonson (Nashville, 1874-1951) was the first African-American self-taught artist given a one-person exhibition at the Museum of Modern Art (1937). Born to former slaves, he was a railroad worker, then a janitor, porter, and assistant stonemaker. He began to carve in 1931, when a series of visions ordered him to serve God through his creations. He made tombstones, carvings and birdbaths with an old hammer and a railroad spike to chisel limestone blocks from demolished buildings and curb stones. The 14.5 inch "Standing Nurse" was featured at Sotheby's January "Important Americana" sale with an estimate of \$275-325,000!
